A word about Email ...

- ✓ WebAccess Outlook Email <u>https://webmail.ccbc.edu</u>
 - You are required to use and maintain your CCBC
 Email account for <u>ALL</u> college email communication.
 - Username Your CCBC Email Address, for example, <u>Joe.Kool@ccbc.edu</u>
 - Password –Default Password set for you, for example - Welcome13579 – This Password expires at approximately <u>220 days</u>. Watch for email notification 30 days prior to expiration.
 - Please Note: Your Email Address (Username) and Password <u>is also</u> your Network Login info needed to access computers on CCBC campus.

 - The "<u>Window</u>" through which we view internet content.

What is Java?

- Java is software that enables "Web-Developed" information to be viewed regardless of the browser or computer you use.
- How do I know if I have the latest version?
- Verify that your version of Java is current -<u>http://www.java.com/en/download/installed.jsp</u>
- Empty your Java Cache <u>http://www.java.com/en/download/help/plugin</u> <u>cache.xml</u>
